Dear

I have to forward you herewith a copy of the instructions for the guidance of resident Tutors and Matrons as approved by the House Committee, the Governors of the College, and the Education Committee, and I am to request that no deviation be made therefrom without the sanction of the Education Committee.

For your information I am to add that the cost of training a student at the College is approximately £120 a year. Towards this sum, each student contributes a fee of £40 a year. The average cost to the Leeds rates for the last six years is about £17,000, or £39 per student, whether from Leeds or other areas.

The Committee look to the resident Tutors and Matrons to co-operate cordially in securing the general efficiency and smooth running of each Hall of Residence and a proper respect on the part of the students for the buildings and furniture belonging to the Local Education Authority.
