Dear Sir.

Thanks for your letter of yesterday. I am glad to know Dr Carey is coming at 11 am. on the 28<sup>th</sup> March. and is bringing his academic robes with him.

In reply to your query about the photos. I am sending you with this a photo of one of my portraits the size I usually have. a 50x40 canvas photographed. This of course is much too large for your book. a page 12" x 10" would require a photo 10" x 8" or even less to look well and that great reduction usually means poor reproduction. I would suggest that we wait until the picture is finished and then we can decide how much of it the photo should include, a head and shoulders or a short half length that would do Dr Carey and the portrait justice would be much better than reproducing the whole picture on a small scale where most of it would be "lost" in the photographing. I think you will agree with this when you see the enclosed photo and imagine it reduced to half the size! Then think how much better it would be to cut down (in proper proportions of course) but we can easily decide where the picture is done & the cost is not serious, a guinea or a guinea and a half should cover it. Please let me have enclosed photo back when you have finished with it.
