COLLEGE RULES.

- 1. Students who wish to be absent from any meal must give previous notice to the matron.
- 2. Week-end leave (Saturday after lectures to Sunday evening) may occasionally be granted at the discretion of the Warden.

 Application for such leave must be made on the prescribed form not later than the Thursday previous to the week-end required.

3. The Hostel will be closed at 10.30 p.m. daily, except on Saturday and Sunday, when special arrangements for late leave will be made.

4. Each student is responsible for his own bed-sitting room.
Personal property must not be left about the hosbel, or in the gymnasium dressing rooms. Bed-sitting room doors should always be left locked when the room is unoccupied.

5. Outdoor boots or shoes must not be worm in the Hostel. Boots and shoes must be cleaned in the cloakroom.

- 6. Every care must be exercised in the use of furniture, fittings and equipment. Any student responsible for damage or breakage must report the matter to the matron, and he will be required to make it good.
- 7. No nail or drawing pin must be driven into any wall, woodwork or furniture in the Hostel.
- 8. Students are strictly forbidden to tamper in any way with the electric fittings. Any failure of lights should immediately be reported to the matron. Electric reading lamps are NOT PERMITTED in study-bedrooms.
- 9. Studded, or spiked boots, must not be worn in any part of the gymnasium block.
- 10. Any student who feels unwell must report to the matron and must not go to bed without so reporting. The College Doctor must not be consulted except on written authority from the matron.
- 11. Students must not be in study-bedrooms during the morning after 9 a.m. The dining room must be vacated immediately after meals to enable the maids to clear. Cutlery and crockery must not be taken upstairs or into the Common Room.
- 12. Post and other duties will be carried out by rota as shown on the Notice Board.
- 13. The telephone must not be used for private calls, except by special permission of the Varden or matron.
- 14. Smoking is prohibited in ANY PART of the GYMNASIUM BLOCK and may only take place in study-bedrooms provided that an efficient ashtray is supplied by the student.
- 15. Women visitors are not permitted in the College, except on Open Days.
