Voluntary Boxing and Fencing Classes.

As many Public and Secondary Schools require the gymnastic master to teach boxing and fencing, VOLUNTARY classes are held weekly from September to Easter for those students who desire instruction in these subjects. It is, however, necessary to charge the following additional fees for this instruction:-

Boxing. £1-10-0 for approximately 30 lessons.

Fencing. £1-10-0 " " "
